AT&T Internet Air for Business 2.0—a fixed wireless solution—can help you stay connected to your customers, suppliers, and employees. When paired with a compatible wireless router (sold separately) that's certified for use on the AT&T 5G Standalone network, AT&T Internet Air for Business 2.0 can provide internet connectivity at qualified service addresses, whether you're expanding locations, building network diversity, or supporting business-critical applications.

What is “fixed wireless”?

“Fixed wireless” refers to wireless devices and services that are used in fixed locations such as an office, pop-up location, or a trailer within a construction site. This contrasts with devices and services that are mobile, such as smartphones and tablets. Fixed wireless solutions are cost effective, can be installed quickly, and can be deployed in areas where fiber internet is not available or cost prohibitive.

Fast and reliable 5G wireless internet

AT&T Internet Air for Business 2.0 can be installed in minutes at your qualified service address and can help solve multiple business challenges. It can be used to establish a wireless internet connection in remote locations or when temporary access is needed. It can also serve as a backup connection when your wired connectivity is interrupted.

What is 5G Standalone?—5G Standalone (5G SA) refers to a 5G network architecture that operates independently of existing 4G LTE infrastructure. Because it does not depend on 4G infrastructure, as our 5G SA network matures, it can deliver better latency, higher upload speeds, higher reliability, and improved network efficiency.

Flexible device options—Choose from compatible devices (sold separately), or bring your own device to create a diverse, flexible, and manageable business network connection using the AT&T 5G wireless network. Compatible devices must be certified for use on the AT&T 5G Standalone network. You can also purchase a compatible external antenna to boost the wireless reception of your router.
