It also assists high school students who are preparing for ACT and SAT college placement exams, as well as those taking AP classes that allow them to earn college credits while working toward graduation.

As Tyrone Benson contemplated retiring from his job at the Department of Veterans Affairs, he wanted to do something different with his life. "When you're retired, you kind of run out of things to do," he said. "I wanted to stay focused, and I wanted to give back to the kids."

Early in his life Benson's mother instilled in him a deep love of learning and a commitment to community service. A voracious reader, she generously shared her passion for reading with her son and many of his friends. His mother's example inspired him to look for ways to serve the community. Catering to the individual

Initially, the company offered in-person lessons. Of course, COVID-19 shut down schools everywhere, so Benson reacted quickly. He migrated the business's operations to virtual and the business took off from there.

Private tutors can be a great resource for students who struggle to keep up with their studies, as well as those looking for a competitive edge boosting ACT or SAT scores. High school students taking AP courses benefit from the opportunity to get a head start on basic college requirements and one-on-one tutoring can help them develop strategies for overcoming hurdles to academic achievement.





Benson said there are many success stories in his business, but one in particular stands out. A high school student came to him struggling with reading comprehension. "She was an AP student," he said. "She made straight As. But reading comprehension was one of her issues."

Benson quickly identified the problem. The student focused more on speed than understanding as she read. Benson created a personalized lesson that specifically addressed the way she learned. He developed visualization techniques that helped her improve her reading comprehension skills.

"Most students are only passionate about what they love," said Benson. "So we took our time and picked passages out of random stories. I read them and visualized them. Then I had her read them and visualize the story. Then we developed questions." This approach helped the student dramatically improve her reading comprehension.

"She aced her AP exam and made me proud," Benson said. Ultimately, the student received acceptance letters from more than one college, including the prestigious Boston College.

Mentoring the mentors

Call Tyrone Tutorial Services seeks out and hires tutors who have strengths in different areas and matches them to students in their discipline. After assigning them the subjects they will be tutoring, Benson challenges the tutors to study two subjects in which they are weak.

"We help them become better at what they're weakest," he said. The practice brings them up to speed on history, calculus, biology, or chemistry. "We want to make sure that they're improving, too."

The Bensons hope to one day operate a brick-andmortar facility that offers kids a welcoming place for learning. Those plans, however, are on hold due to the continuing uncertainty surrounding COVID.
