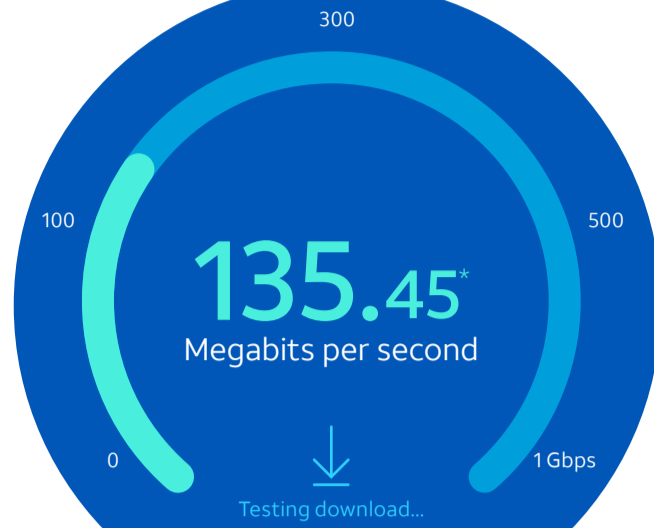

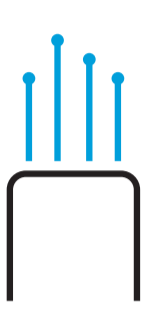

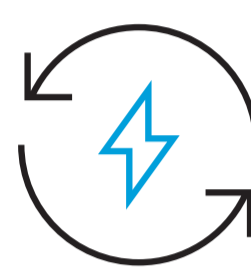


Fiber optic technology uses cables made of glass or plastic strands.

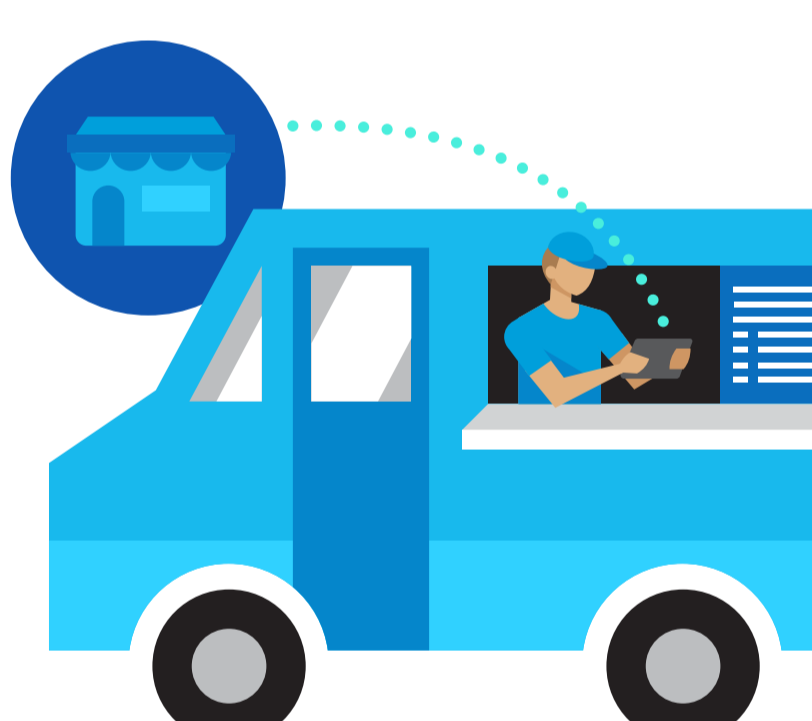

Use case:

Small Restaurant
