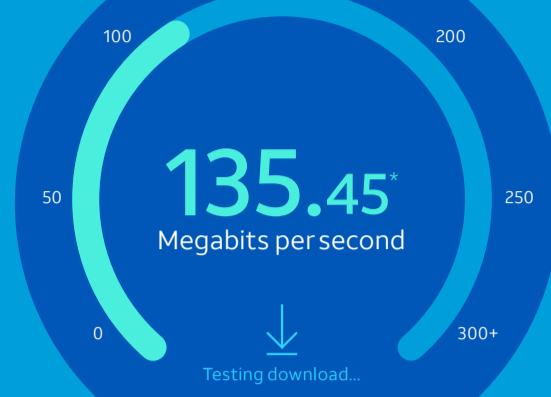

A fiber optic connection uses cable made up of glass fiber strands.

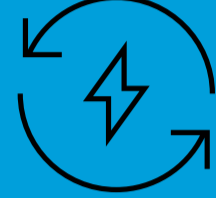
Fiber internet is a technology that uses fiber optic cables. A fiber optic connection transmits information through light over small flexible glass fibers. Fiber refers to "glass" while "optic" refers to light. It is not made up of "plastic" strands.



This transmits light, which is faster, more efficient, and secure

when compared to copper.

Fiber can transmit **more information.**



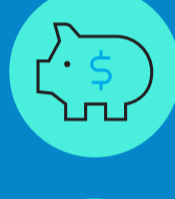
