FAQs about AT&T International Calling

Q: How can I get international long distance service added to my account?

A: To add international long distance service on your account, simply log in to myAT&T and select Manage add-ons under the line of service you want to add AT&T International Calling to. Look for the Explore add-ons section and click International and select Call/text another country from the U.S and complete the opt-in process.

Q: Does AT&T offer discounted pay-per-use rates for international long distance calling?

A: Yes. When you add an AT&T International Calling package for \$15/month per device to a qualified rate plan, you'll get unlimited calling from the U.S. to over 85 countries. You'll also enjoy discounted calling rates to over 140 other countries.

Q: Are there any special international calling plans for **Canada and Mexico?**

A: AT&T offers unlimited domestic rate plans that include unlimited calling from the U.S. to Mexico and Canada. Simply log in to myAT&T and check if your plan has unlimited calling - to Mexico and Canada.

Q: How do I make an international long distance call from the U.S. to Canada, Mexico and other countries?

A: When calling to Canada, Jamaica, and Caribbean locations, you simply dial a 1 plus the local number of the recipient.

When calling Mexico, you simply dial +52, followed by the area code and local number.

To make other international calls from the U.S., simply dial + (or 011), followed by the country code and local number you wish to call.

Example: To call from the U.S. to France: +33 (local number)

Q: How are international long distance pay-per-use calls charged?

A: International long distance calling rates are charged per minute and rounded up to the nearest minute and apply for calls made from the U.S. to another country. Calling to some countries may not be available.

Q: Will I be charged international long distance rates to call U.S. territories?

A: No, with AT&T wireless service, calls to Puerto Rico, U.S. Virgin Islands (St. Croix, St. John, and St. Thomas), Guam, and Northern Mariana Islands are considered domestic calls.

Q: Can I block international calls from being made from my cell phone?

A: Yes. Just call AT&T Customer Care at 866.MOBILITY and request that international calls be blocked.

Q: How do I send a text, picture, or video message from the U.S. to another country?

A: To send any international message, dial "+" followed by the country code and local number.

Example: +44 1234567

Tip: With most phones, the + sign will appear if you press and hold down the 0 key.

Q: What options are available for customers who want to send a text message from the U.S to an international number?

A: Unlimited texting from the U.S. to 200+ countries is included in select domestic postpaid plans. Simply log in to myAT&T and check if your plan has this benefit.

If your plan does not include unlimited texting from the US, you can send messages on a pay-per-use basis.

International Text Messages:

- To send: \$0.25/text
- To receive: Standard domestic messaging rates apply

International Picture/Video Messages:

- To send: \$0.50/text
- To receive: Standard domestic messaging rates apply
