The backup connectivity your business needs

Internet connectivity is the lifeblood of your business. But what if your primary internet connection suffers an outage? How will you keep your business running? When paired with compatible routers (sold separately), AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled plans provide wireless internet for intermittent backup use. These plans can help keep your business applications up and running when your primary internet connection is unavailable. With the pooled data functionality, unused monthly data allowances associated with one location can help you offset overages incurred by another location in the Data Pool.¹

Pool data to help avoid overages

AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled plans let you pool your allocated data across locations with the same plan. It's a flexible, cost-effective solution that helps you get the most from the data you pay for. Now you can minimize wasting data where you don't use it and reduce or eliminate overage charges from heavy use.

We make it easy: Data balancing happens automatically each month, and your bill will show any available credits and applicable overage charges.

How pooled data works

Pooled data can help you deal with unused wireless data and overage charges across similar plans within a single billing account.¹

For example, if you select AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled 1GB plans for routers at three business locations (A, B, and C), you would have a Data Pool consisting of 3GB per month. If your primary internet connection at location A suffers an outage that results in overage charges for the pooled plan at location A, locations B and C can share their plans' unused data allowances to help offset those charges via bill credits.²

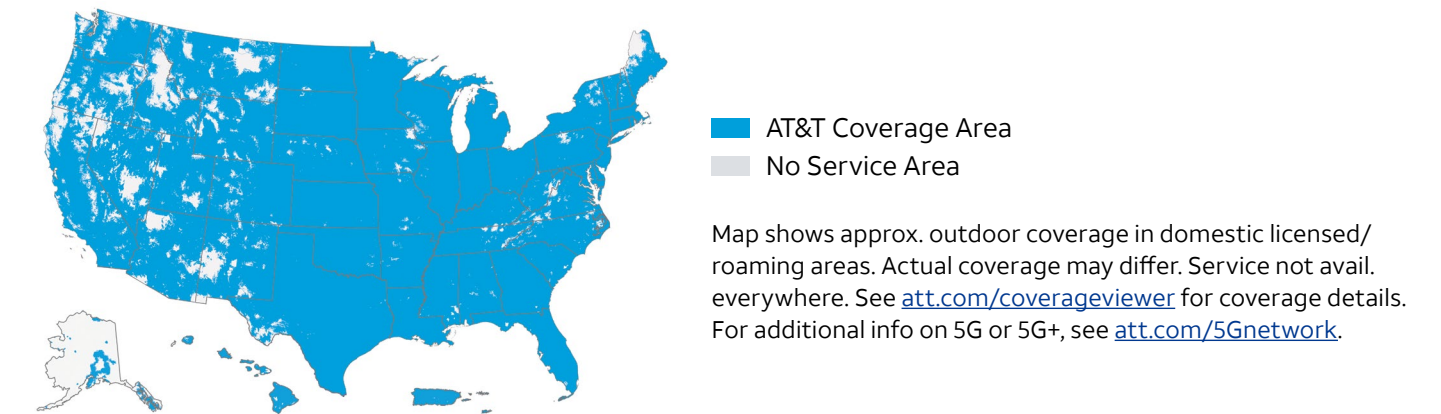
Plans cannot be used to backup AT&T wireless or fixed wireless internet solutions (such as AT&T Internet Air® for Business).

For Corporate Responsibility User (**CRU**) lines of service only. **All wireless services are subject to the terms and conditions of your Business Agreement.** **AVAILABILITY:** Plans require sufficient cellular coverage to work optimally. **To maximize performance, you should assess whether you are in an AT&T owned and operated coverage area and whether there is sufficient in building coverage at your desired location prior to purchase.** Additionally, AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled service does not work in the event of a loss of power unless you have battery backup (battery sold separately). **SERVICE RESTRICTIONS:** AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled is a backup wireless internet access service that offers the capability for acquiring or retrieving information from; generating, storing, transforming, processing, or utilizing information on; or making available information to other internet end points connected directly or indirectly via a fixed wireless connection to the AT&T network. Plans are intended solely for intermittent, temporary use as a backup connection during an outage of your qualified primary internet service; they may not be used to back up other AT&T wireless or fixed wireless services. Additionally, plans are not intended for high bit rate applications and may not be used for server devices or host computer applications (such as continuous web camera posts or broadcasts), for high bandwidth applications,

services or content that disproportionately and excessively contribute to network congestion (such as web broadcasting), or in any other manner prohibited by your Business Agreement (see prohibited network uses/activities in the Additional Service and Equipment-Related Terms at att.com/abs-addtl-terms or comparable provisions of your Business Agreement & see the AT&T Acceptable Use Policy at att.com/aup).

DEVICES: Each plan is limited to one CRU line and requires a compatible wireless router (sold separately) supporting business applications. **PRICING:** Monthly pricing includes a monthly plan charge for data service only. **OTHER RESTRICTIONS AND FEES:** Activation/upgrade fee per line (up to \$50) and deposit may apply. If you purchased a device that requires a service term commitment, an **Early Termination/Cancellation Fee** of up to \$750 applies if you cancel service after the first 30 days and before your service term ends. See att.com/equipmentETF for details on what fee may apply for your device and how the fee is prorated over time. Credit approval may be required. AT&T reserves the right to suspend or terminate service to your account pursuant to your Business Agreement and/or place any noncomplying device on an appropriate plan. **ADDITIONAL AT&T FEES AND GOVT. TAXES:** Monthly AT&T fees apply per line and include Regulatory Cost Recovery Fee (up to \$1.50), Administrative Fee (up to \$3.49 effective August 5, 2026), Property Tax Allotment Fee (\$0.20-\$0.45) and other AT&T fees which are not government-required. Additional one-time Fees may apply. Govt. taxes are extra. See att.com/mobilityfees for more details. **DATA:** Each plan includes a monthly allotment of data (**Data Allowance**) for use within the United States (**Domestic Coverage Area** or **DCA**). Data Allowances must be used in the billing period provided or will be forfeited. Tethering permitted with compatible devices. See att.com/broadbandinfo for details on AT&T network management practices. **Data Overage:** If you exceed your Data Allowance during a billing period, additional data will be provided automatically at a pay-per-use rate of \$5 per GB. **POOLED DATA:** The plans include pooled data at a Billing Account Number (**BAN**) level. Within each BAN, all lines activated with an AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled plan that has the same Data Allowance will be combined to create an AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled **data pool** (Data Pool). For example: If your BAN has 3 lines on AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled 1GB plans, those lines would be combined to form a Data Pool. If the same BAN also has 4 lines on AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled 5GB plans, those lines will not be part of the Data Pool for the 1GB plans; rather, the AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled 5GB plans will be combined to form a separate Data Pool. **No other type of pooled data plan can be part of the Data Pool.** Every billing period, each line in a Data Pool first uses its plan's Data Allowance. If a line does not use all of its Data Allowance, an underage is created in the amount of the unused Data Allowance (**Under Usage**). If a line uses more than its Data Allowance, the line incurs Data Overage charges in the amount of the excess data usage (**Over Usage**). At the end of the billing period, AT&T calculates the total Under Usage and Over Usage amounts for all lines in the Data Pool and then compares the two totals. If the total Under Usage amount exceeds the total Over Usage amount, the total Under Usage is allocated among the lines in the Data Pool with Over Usage (if any), resulting in per line credits on your invoice equal to each such line's Data Overage charges. Any remaining Under Usage for the billing period will be forfeited. If the total Over Usage amount exceeds the total Under Usage amount (and the total Under Usage amount is greater than zero), then the total Under Usage is divided by the total Over Usage to create an allocation factor that is applied equally to each line's Data Overage charges to determine each such line's share of the total Under Usage amount, resulting in per line credits on your invoice to partially offset each such line's Data Overage charges. For example: If a Data Pool for 5GB plans has a total of 100KB of Under Usage and 1,000KB of Over Usage (which means an allocation factor of 10%), then your invoice will show, with respect to each line in the Data Pool with Over Usage, both (a) the line's Data Overage charges at a rate of \$5 per GB, and (b) a bill credit equal to 10% of the line's Data Overage charges. Migrating lines to different plans during a billing period may result in one-time prorations or other impacts to the credit calculation. **Limits:** Each BAN is limited to a maximum of 4 Data Pools (that is, one Data Pool for each of the four AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled plan options). Your BAN may also have one or more data pool(s) for CRU lines on other types of pooled data plans, such as AT&T Mobile Select – Pooled or AT&T Business Pooled Nation for Data, but CRU lines in a Data Pool for AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled cannot take advantage of any other data pool's Under Usage and vice versa. **DATA SPEEDS:** The speed of AT&T Business Wireless Backup Pooled service is very dependent upon the connection your wireless router can achieve with the AT&T mobile network. Many things can affect the availability and quality of your service including, but not limited to, your location's proximity to the cell site, the position of your device within your location, local congestion caused by use of network capacity by high numbers of users simultaneously using data intensive applications in the vicinity of the cell tower serving your location, blockage of the signal between your location and the cell tower (caused by objects such as buildings, foliage, etc.), AT&T network management practices, and weather. As such, **performance, experience, and speeds will vary and are not guaranteed.** **VIDEO STREAMING:** AT&T aims to render streaming video in standard definition (max of 2 Mbps for customers on both 5G-enabled devices and rate plans or 1.5 Mbps for other customers) though some video cannot be identified. Sometimes, other content that content providers bundle with streaming video may be impacted and slowed, including downloads. In certain situations, AT&T may deliver video content faster or at higher definition. To experience higher definition video when available, or if you have an issue, turn the feature off or back on any time at att.com/premier. Details at att.com/videofeature. **5G SERVICE:** Requires a compatible 5G device and a service location in a 5G coverage area. Coverage not available everywhere. See att.com/5Gnetwork for details. **5G+ SERVICE:** Requires a compatible 5G+ device and a service location in a 5G+ coverage area. Coverage available only in limited locations in specific cities. See att.com/5Gnetwork for cities. Other restrictions apply. **COVERAGE:** Coverage is not available everywhere, subject to change without notice, and not guaranteed. **OFF-NET USAGE:** Domestic off-net (roaming) data usage may be at 2G speeds.
